Rejoice In Celebration

A time of merriment, celebration, birth, success, and victory is at hand. You're doing what you love most and pursuing your passion. When you follow your heart and intuition with passion, there are no limits to what you can achieve. When the energy of excitement and love is present, you can all feel it moving within you. Somehow, love has a way of showing us that we are connected to something much larger than ourselves. The number 3 symbolizes unity and a time to rejoice in gratitude and sharing, whether it's with family, friends, or even co-workers. This is a time of fruition for all your dedicated work, so pat yourself on the back, party and dance in celebration of your accomplishments!

Harmony

This card signifies the possibility of a deep spiritual initiation, partnership, or union is taking place at this time or one that's manifesting for the future. This does not necessarily represent a love affair of the heart, but could signify other forms of relationships in your life whether they're personal or business. Remember not *all* relationships have to be one-to-one. They can be forged with a group, an organization, a pet, or even an incident or situation.

The *Harmony Card* calls to you to let you know that's time for you to make choices in certain relationships. Relationships of all kinds are really about *you*, even in the hardest situations. They're meant to be mirrors for us, always reflecting back what we need to see,

Ask yourself: "What am I learning from this relationship?" "What new qualities am I developing?" "Is this relationship for my highest good?" "How can I make this relationship stronger?" "Are we learning from each other?" "What have I learnt or still learning about myself through this relationship?" "Are the people in my life empowering and encouraging me to be all that I can be?" Within every relationship, there's an encoded lesson that you've hopefully learned or in some cases one you still need to learn.

Balance

This card represents the need for balance and harmony with your inner life, as well as what's surrounding you in your physical world. This card denotes that some lifestyle adjustments are required at this time. It could be associated with love, relationships, business, or even your career.

The *Balance Card* is also being to shown to you to make you realize that what you perceive may be happening in your outer world is really an externalization of an inner process or conflict that you may be experiencing at this time. At times this card will often appear if someone works in the legal field, or when you're involved in legal matters. Have faith that justice will triumph. Justice and karma go hand and hand. Take only what you have earned, treat people fairly, and don't take advantage of people – these are all part of living a balanced karmic life.

When making decisions, there must be a state of balance: emotionally, mentally, physically, and spiritually so that you can make rational decisions and logical judgments. This is a time to be honest and caring, to be responsible for the choices that you have made as well as the ones that will be made in the future.
